Jail Video Surveillance System Refresh
Addendum #1

1. Executive Summary
 - "The existing Bosch storage NAS devices will be reconfigured as standard NAS devices and used to provide **archive** storage for recorded video."
 - **Is the existing Bosch storage NAS devices to be used to "archive" recorded video data or is the intention to use them as the primary storage for the new VMS?**
 1. The intention is to use the current storage devices as storage for the new system unless the integrator determines that this is not possible with their proposed solution.
2. Cameras
 - "All cameras must have the ability to remotely focus the image from a PC. Manually focused cameras are not acceptable."
 - **Does this mean cameras with fixed lenses are not acceptable?**
 1. Cameras must be able to be focused from a PC and not require manual intervention (such as opening up the unit and manually adjusting the focus)
3. Video Management System (VMS)
 - "The existing footage must be retained for a minimum of 121 days for specific cameras. The integrator will work with the owner to determine which footage must be retained and which footage can be overwritten immediately. The existing Bosch management server will be kept in use until the old footage is no longer needed. The integrator may use temporary storage or move footage as necessary to maintain the old footage. The old footage will need to be searchable as required by the owner."
 - **It is feasible that existing footage could be 90.510 TB of existing recorded video data. Is it the responsibility of the integrator to provide this much "temporary" storage?**
 1. It is the responsibility of the integrator to provide any necessary "temporary" storage. The amount of video that needs to be maintained and moved will be determined by jail staff based on any current/pending requests and/or needs
4. Cabling and Network Equipment
 - "New PoE switches will be provided by the integrator to connect and power all new cameras."
 - **In addition to the existing security electronics closets, will the facility allow network equipment and new camera cabling to be installed in any other rooms or closets?**
 1. It is the preference of Marinette County to use existing closets where possible however utilization of other closets is not prohibited if the new locations are secure, contain proper HVAC and other requirements and meet jail inspection requirements.
5. Control Room Viewing Stations
 - "The integrator shall provide new client PCs capable of viewing 32 cameras at once for each of the (3) existing monitors."
 - **At the walk through, Mr. Solway stated that the County will be providing the workstations. Can you please clarify?**
 1. It is the intention of Marinette County to provide the PC's/Servers (Physical or Virtual) based on specific integrator recommendations.
