Request for Proposal #15-010-28: Forestry Department
Services for Chemically Treating Cut Stumps

1) What species need to be treated? Do pines need to be treated also or only species that resprout?

The main objective is to treat stumps of oak and maple along with stumps of other species that may resprout.

2) If this information is available - What is the average number of stumps/acre? What are the average diameters?

The average stumps/acre varies some. I don't have that number. The diameters range from 4 inches to 20+ inches.

3) Are there specific herbicides that the county will allow or prohibit?

The herbicide listed in the RFP is the one to be used. It is triclopyr.

4) What is an acceptable success rate for prevention of regrowth?

We are hoping to get 80+% prevention.

5) What is the probable start date that applications can be made?

The start date can occur once the RFPs have been gone through and the Forestry & Parks Committee award the work.

6) Are there any accepted *Chemically treated cut stump proposals* from previous years that are available for my review?

This is the first *Chemically treated cut stump proposal* we have done. I have nothing for you to review.
