



# Fall Colors Driving Tour Directions

*the real north*  
MARINETTE COUNTY

**Know before you go:** A \$5 Marinette County parking pass is required for park entry. (1 pass / vehicle)  
Passes are available at any Marinette County park entrance & are valid for all County parks the day of purchase.

## #1 Dave's Falls |

*Dave's Falls is a must-see in The Real North! Bring your camera and enjoy autumn colors in the backdrop of the falls along the Pike River.*  
US Hwy 141 9 mi north of Wausaukee or 0.5mi south of Amberg

## #2 Strong Falls |

*Located on the Peshtigo River inside Goodman Park, Strong Falls is an easy walk from the parking lot.*  
*Relax on the rocks or hike the trails that connect to nearby McClintock Park.*

- **Scenic Route involves gravel roads:** Exit Dave's Falls by turning left onto US Hwy 141 | Continue on US Hwy 141 for 0.8mi  
Turn left onto County V | Follow the signs to stay on County V for 2.2mi  
Turn right onto Nutt Rd for 1.8mi | Turn right onto Mathis Rd for 0.8mi | Turn left onto Benson Lake Road for 4.8mi  
Turn right to stay on Benson Lake Road | Go 0.9mi and veer left to stay on Benson Lake Rd | Continue 7.7mi  
At the intersection of County I and Benson Lake Rd continue straight to stay on Benson Lake Rd | Continue 0.9mi  
Turn left onto Goodman Park Rd (Rustic Route 32) | After 0.3mi turn right into Goodman Park
- **Paved Route:** Exit Dave's Falls by turning left onto US Hwy 141 | Continue on US Hwy 141 for 0.8mi | turn left onto County V  
Follow the signs to stay on County V for 6.6mi | Turn right onto County C for 3.3mi | Turn left onto County AC for 1.7mi  
Turn right onto County C for 8.7mi | Turn right onto Parkway Rd / County I for 9.2mi | Continue straight onto Goodman Park Rd

## #3 McClintock Rapids |

*Enjoy the series of rapids from wooden foot bridges that connect small islands across the Peshtigo River.*  
*An old stone grill, log day-use cabins and a tranquil creek are some of the gems that await you at this stop.*  
Exit Goodman Park to the right onto Goodman Park Rd | The road name changes to County I or Parkway Rd  
Continue 3.2mi and turn right into McClintock Park

## #4 Thunder Mountain Overlook |

*This peak provides a view overlooking western Marinette County including the High Falls Flowage.*  
*Grassy hiking trails guide visitors around the scenic hills and to DIY photo stations around the park.*  
Exit McClintock Park to the right and continue 7.1mi | Turn left onto County C for 0.5mi  
Turn right to continue on Parkway Rd | Continue 10.8mi | Turn right onto Thunder Mountain Rd for 1mi  
At the intersection of Caldron Falls Rd and Thunder Mountain Rd, continue straight | Go 2.1mi into the park

## #5 Veteran's Falls |

*Watch the Thunder River roar down the falls from a wooden foot bridge at this final stop on the Fall Colors Driving Tour.*  
Depart Thunder Mountain Overlook Park by driving downhill with caution | Go 2.1mi on Thunder Mountain Rd  
At the intersection of Thunder Mountain Rd and Caldron Falls Rd, go straight for 1mi  
Turn right onto Parkway Rd | Continue 1.6mi to Veteran's Park on the right

### Back to Highway 141/Crivitz

Depart Veteran's Falls and turn right onto Parkway Rd | Follow Parkway Rd for 3mi to County W  
Turn left onto W and continue for 10.8 mi into Crivitz | Turn left on Louisa St  
Continue one block to the stop sign | Turn right on Henriette Ave and continue 0.3mi to US 141
