

# CHILDREN'S LONG TERM SERVICES

Children's Waiver Program  
Children's Community Options Program



-The Children's Long-Term Support (CLTS) Waiver Program is a Home and Community-Based Service (HCBS) Waiver that provides Medicaid funding for children who have substantial limitations in their daily activities and need support to remain in their home or community.

Eligible children include those with developmental disabilities, severe emotional disturbances, and physical disabilities.

Funding can be used to support a range of different services based on an assessment of the needs of the child and his or her family.

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All children or young adults must meet the basic requirements listed below for CLTS Waiver eligibility. To qualify for certain types of funding, there may be additional requirements (see below).

**To participate in the CLTS Waiver, your child must:**

- be under 18 years of age;
- be eligible for Wisconsin Medicaid, including:
- be a United States citizen or have acceptable immigration status;
- be a Wisconsin resident;
- not have income in their name in excess of the current Medicaid standards;
- live at home or in a foster care setting;



- have a level of care need that is typically provided in an institutional setting such as a hospital, a nursing home, or an institution for people with developmental disabilities; and
- Be able to receive safe and appropriate care at home and/or in the community;
- -There is a wide variety of services that may be available through the CLTS Waiver/CCOP programs to meet the individual needs and goals of your child and family.



**Process:**

All services start with a referral form. This form can be obtained on <http://www.marinettecounty.com/departments/>. Click on Health and Human Services and then on Children's Long Term Services. Or you may email [CCS@marinettecounty.com](mailto:CCS@marinettecounty.com) and request a referral form.

When a referral form is received an application will be sent out to the family. Once the application is received back a CLTS case worker will contact you to begin the process.

Things the CLTS worker will need provided from the family in order to proceed through the process:

- Copy of Birth Certificate
- Proof of disability diagnosis (which can include physical, cognitive, or mental health)
- Proof of income
- Copy of the most recent IEP if available
