1. Call to Order. Roll Call.

Chair Albright called the meeting to order at 10:07 a.m.

5. Correspondence.

Lt. Albright received information for free tutorials on community maps. Mike Panosh will present information on community maps at next meeting.

6. Highway Department Report.

Ray Palonen reported all 2015 paving and construction projects completed except crack filling work is still in progress on Hwy 141 north of Wausaukee. Next Spring the Highway Department would like to partner with Sheriff's Office and use speed grant funds to help assist worker's safety in work zones.

7. State Patrol Traffic Report.

State Trooper Eric Dante commented that Trooper VanNoie has been very proactive while monitoring Marinette County.

8. Marinette Police Department Traffic Report.

Sgt. Joe Nault stated the OWI Task Force has been quite busy with 291 stops, 14 arrests and 250 citations issued. Canine assists increasing with the increase of drug activity.

9. School Related Traffic Report.

None at this time.

10. D.O.T. Traffic Concerns and Updates.

Randy Asman reported that 2015 construction projects are completed. In 2016 the HWY 180 resurfacing project will begin and also the Wausaukee project. DOT held an internal kickoff meeting recently regarding HWY 41/Kamm Road safety project and will be organizing future public meetings to discuss possible alternatives.

11. B.O.T.S. Information and Updates.

Mike Panosh reported to date there have been 482 fatalities in the State of Wisconsin compared to 416 in 2014. To date there have been 4 fatalities in Marinette County. Dr. Magnin inquired about drivers having lights on vehicles 24 hours a day for safety. Mike Panosh responded that periodically legislation reviews lights mandating. After an evaluation of guidelines by the Bureau of Traffic Safety, Panosh commented that Marinette County Traffic Safety Committee is doing a great job

12. Marinette County Sheriff's Office Traffic Report.

Lt. Albright reported three fatalities in Marinette County since last meeting: Town of Beaver, one vehicle, speed a factor; Town of Grover, motorcycle, alcohol a factor; Town of Pound, car/deer. Sheriff's Office continues OWI Task Force participation. Marinette County will hire two additional officers in 2016.
