One member of the governing body of the town, village or city within which the largest portion by valuation of the district lies, appointed by the governing body and owning property within the district if possible. Three electors or owners of property within the district elected by secret ballot by the qualified electors and property owners within the district. At least one of the elected commissioners shall be a resident of the district.
