Section 2.04 - COUNTY BOARD RULES OF PROCEDURES

 - Marinette County Health & Human Services: Provides urban local transportation for the needs of the elderly and disabled. Strives to enhance local transportation services without competing or duplication of services.
 - Expressed concern for funding in regards to the future needs of our growing elderly populations ~ referred to as a "Silver Tsunami".
 - Discussed the donations/fair box revenue for transport vehicles.
 - Overviewed contracts between Marinette County and Marinette County Elderly Services.
 - The total funding request is \$151,553 with a County match of \$30,311.00. Marinette County Elderly Services to receive \$90,932 upon receipt of funding.
 - Expressed concern about when legislatures may not understand the impact this program has on people and we need to do our best to advocate for these services for Senior's.
 - Noted also that socialization is very important to the wellbeing of our senior population.
 - Discussed the dangerous traffic on the highway in front of the senior center and possible contacts that we can reach out to for help regarding that.
 - NewCap is building a new 45 unit housing facility which may generate more need for this type of transportation.
