Chapter 2 – COUNTY GOVERNMENT

Section 2.04 - COUNTY BOARD RULES OF PROCEDURES

(7)(k) Rules of Order. Any person not a member of the Board/Committee, desirous of addressing the Board/Committee under public comment on any subject, shall first obtain permission from the Board/Committee Chairperson. All such addresses shall be limited to 5 minutes unless otherwise extended by the Board/Committee Chairperson.

(10)(a) Suspending, Changing and Interpreting the Rules. These rules may be suspended by affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members present. The vote on any motion to suspend the rules shall be taken by roll call vote.

1. **Call to order.** Glenn Sartorelli called the hearing to order at 10:03 am.
2. **MOTION (MUELLER-JOHNSON/BASAK)** to approve agenda. Motion carried.
3. **Public Comment.** ~ *Dave Gregersen, Marinette County Transportation Coordinator, shared how this service has particularly helped an elderly couple whose wife is wheelchair bound. They are so thankful for the program. Dave noted that most of the people that are really in need are also very appreciative. Mary Basak, Elderly Services of Marinette County, overviewed their "Medical Escort" program. Pam Mueller-Johnson, Elderly Services Director, expressed the dire need in the County for these services and further overviewed the impact that transportation services for those that need them. George Kloppenburg, Marinette County Board Supervisor, expressed his concern if services were to be reduced. Glenn Sartorelli, Marinette County Deputy Director, noted his concerns for the future influx of an aging population that will be in need of these types of services. Glenn noted that it is so much more cost effective for them to be able to stay in their home where they are also more comfortable and have a better quality of life.*
4. **MOTION (BASAK/SARTORELLI)** to approve the minutes of the December 16, 2016 meeting. Motion carried.
5. Overviewed and discussed the 2018 s85.21 Grant Process.
 - History of grant funding overviewed as well as changes implemented due to Family Care.
 - Overviewed the Transportation Coordinator position and how it has helped Marinette County move forward with enhancing services for consumers without competing with for-profit transportation entities in the area.
 - Overviewed State allocations and requirements to serve the senior and developmentally disabled populations. Submission of application due by 12/15/17.

- Overviewed reporting requirements and process.
 - Discussed how Marinette County Health & Human Services and Elderly Services of Marinette County can further collaborate to further enhance services.
 - Discussion regarding providing short and simple presentations at Board Meetings to further educate community leaders on the current and future needs of the growing senior population.
 - Suggestion to add a simple tagline to the next Public Hearing notice to help clarify what the “hearing” is about.
 - Overviewed how Elderly Services provides transportation services to Lakeland and Care Wisconsin.
 - Suggestion for Marinette County Health & Human Services to create a transportation brochure to help with community awareness of the program and it’s services.
