Chair Jason Ducane called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

6. Highway Department Report.

HWY Commissioner Rick Rickaby reported there will be paving of seven miles on CO W; concrete panel replacement on HWY 141; new ATV routes reviewed and approved.

7. State Patrol Traffic Report.

Sgt. Andrew Hyer reported that State Patrol will be focusing on impaired driving and seat belt usage during summer driving season. Memorial weekend enforcing "Click It or Ticket" program.

8. Marinette Police Department Traffic Report.

Sgt. Mark Menor reported there is currently construction on Riverside Avenue replacing street, sidewalks and gutters. Small road project on Eggner Street.

9. School Related Traffic Report.

Tom Westlund reported the last day of school is June 8th.

10. D.O.T. Traffic Concerns and Updates.

Randy Asman commented signals will be upgraded next year on intersection HWY 41/CO T/Roosevelt.

11. B.O.T.S. Information and Update.

Mike Panosh reported to date there have been 168 fatalities in the State of Wisconsin compared to 167 in 2017. There have been 6 motorcycle fatalities in 2018 compared to 9 in 2017. May 21st – June 3rd is the nationwide “Click It or Ticket” enforcement program. Wisconsin has 90% compliant use with seatbelts. High risk fatality group and lower seatbelt use among pickup trucks and rural areas.

Randy Wiessinger commented that Community Maps has new searches as a useful tool and county profile information. Four out of ten motorcyclists are improperly licensed. Governor’s Conference August 21-23, 2018 in Lake Geneva.

12. Marinette County Sheriff’s Office Traffic Report.

Lt. Ducane reported Marinette County had two traffic fatalities. Lt. Ducane attended the Regional Safety meeting in Brown County and commented the Safe Ride program in Marinette County is very successful. Speed trailer being used throughout the county. Reminder to use headlights during inclement weather.
