County Administrator John LeFebvre made recommendation to County Board on March 26, 2019 to appoint Supervisor Al Mans as Infrastructure representative on Traffic Safety Committee.

7. Highway Department Report.

Eric Burmeister commented it was a brutal winter for HWY Department. Winter maintenance budget has been depleted. Flooding areas are being identified with culvert/sink holes replacement.

8. State Patrol Traffic Report.

Looking forward to summer.

9. Marinette Police Department Traffic Report.

Sgt. Mark Menor reported speeding vehicles on Hall Avenue intersections an ongoing problem. MPD using high visibility enforcement and zero tolerance. There will be three days in June, July and August to enforce Aggressive Driving Grant. There are downed signal lights currently at intersection of Stephenson/Hall Avenue and also Hattie Street.

10. School Related Traffic Report.

Tom Westlund reported the last day of school in Marinette/Peshtigo is Friday, June 7th. Summer school runs from June 17th – July 19th. May 8th is National Report School Bus Passing Violations. Tom thanked Officers for assistance with school bus passing violations.

11. D.O.T. Traffic Concerns and Updates.

None at this time.

12. B.O.T.S. Information and Update.

Mike Panosh and Randy Wiessinger reported to date there have been 146 fatalities in the State of Wisconsin compared to 161 in 2018. Click It or Ticket will be enforced from May 20th – June 2nd. Marinette Police Department was awarded \$4,000.00 to spend on enforcement based equipment. Randy demonstrated different areas in Community Maps to access information and how crashes are analyzed. Possible Legislative Bills being introduced are: Ignition Interlock for all OWI offenses, OWI mandatory 12-hour hold, Adopt a Highway Protection, electronic scooters on roadways and various OWI related Bills.

13. Marinette County Sheriff's Office Traffic Report.

One fatality since last meeting in April in the Town of Niagara: failed to stop at stop sign, struck embankment, no seatbelt use, alcohol a factor.

14. HWY 41 & CO T concerns.

Randy Asman stated a traffic count will be done at the intersection of HWY 41 & CO T and the data will be analyzed for possible signal changes. Eric Burmeister has met with City of Marinette representatives about pedestrian traffic and traffic congestion concerns.
