



INMATE MAIL

We understand that receiving mail from family and friends is very important and in some cases is the only means of communicating, however, the safety and security of the jail is our highest priority.

All mail received at the Marinette County Jail that contains any of the following: unknown substances, staining, discoloration, glitter, glue, perfume or odor, lipstick, stickers, colored pencils, crayon or marker will be marked undeliverable and confiscated. It will then be placed in the inmate's personal property where it will remain until the inmate is released. All contents of that letter will be considered as questionable and placed in the property bag. NO Copies will be made and review of those materials will be at the discretion of the Jail Sergeant on duty at the time of non-delivery. ALL decisions are final.

Inmates can receive books and magazines however all books and magazines must be mailed in directly from a book store, publisher, or mail order company. All books must be paperback, NO HARD COVERED BOOKS ALLOWED. NO MAIL OR READING MATERIAL will be accepted at the front desk by the general public.
