Interim HWY Commissioner Eric Burmeister updated committee on CO W project.

7. State Patrol Traffic Report.

Sgt. Andrew Hyer reported that State Patrol has been quite busy with traffic direction at parades, Winnebago County events-EAA, Rock USA and Country USA, Click It or Ticket program, and helping with assistance requests from counties.

8. Marinette Police Department Traffic Report.

Sgt. Mark Menor reported Riverside Avenue project is scheduled for completion the end of October. Marinette PD involved in OWI Task Force and seat belt enforcement.

9. School Related Traffic Report.

Tom Westlund reported the first day of school is September 4th and thanked both Marinette PD and Sheriff's Office for handling school bus passing complaints.

10. D.O.T. Traffic Concerns and Updates.

Scott Nelson informed committee that pedestrian crossing flashing signals are in use.

11. B.O.T.S. Information and Update.

Randy Wiessinger reported to date there have been 334 fatalities in the State of Wisconsin compared to 352 in 2017. Pedestrian fatalities are down this year. Statewide survey on seat belt use is being completed. There is a seat belt app available for counties. Governor's Safety Conference August 21-23, 2018 in Lake Geneva. Crash map was reviewed.

12. Marinette County Sheriff's Office Traffic Report.

Lt. Ducane reported Marinette County had 3 traffic fatalities since last meeting:

1. July 3rd, Town of Beaver, lone vehicle, lone occupant, speed and alcohol factors.
2. July 19th, Town of Silver Cliff, vehicle vs. logging truck.
3. July 21st, Town of Beaver, vehicle struck tree, lone occupant.

Lt. Ducane met with County Supervisor Glenn Broderick in the Town of Pound regarding road safety concerns.
