To make a visitation appointment call (715) 732-7630. Appointments can only be made Monday-Friday between the hours of 8:00-4:30. Appointments must be scheduled at least one business day before the visit. No same day visits will be made.

- Visits are by appointment only
- All visitors must be on the inmates Approved Visitors List. The visitors list is filled out by the inmate and must have the visitors name, address, telephone number and date of birth. Inmates are allowed to have up to 6 visitors on their list. The jail receptionist must have this list before an appointment can be made.
- Visitors must be at least 12 years old to visit. Visitors between the ages of 12-17 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian (inmate does not count) and have picture id (school id is acceptable) AND birth certificate or legal guardianship paperwork.
- At the set appointment time visitor will come to the jail reception window to check in with picture id.
- No items will be allowed in the visiting booths. Lockers are provided at the jail to the left of the reception window where you can secure your belongings. Lockers require a quarter deposit which will be returned to you when you replace the key to gather your things. Purses, cell phones, pen and paper, pictures and food or drink are not allowed. You will be asked to place these things in a locker.
- Jackets and hats must be removed before entering the visitation booth, there is a spot to hang coats to the left of the lockers.
- Two people are allowed to visit at one time. When two people visit at the same appointment time that will count as one visit.
- If there is room, two appointments can be put back to back for a longer visit; however this will be counted as two visits.
- Any visitor under the influence of any drug or alcohol will not be allowed to visit. You may be asked to submit to a PBT (breathalyzer).
- You will be required to pass through a metal detector, if you set the alarm off, back up, let everyone else in line pass through and the jail receptionist will assist you.
- Visits are no contact; there is glass between the visitor and the inmate. You must pick up the phones to speak. Any visitors not using the phone to communicate will have their visit terminated.
- Any disruptive behavior by the inmate or visitor will terminate the visit.
- Any visitor causing a disturbance may have their visiting privileges revoked indefinitely.
- Sitting on the ledges in the visiting booth is not permitted.
- You may only speak to the inmate you are scheduled to visit. Speaking to any other inmate will result in your visit being terminated.

Other Misc Info

- The only items that will be allowed to be dropped off at the jail for an inmate are: prescription medications and approved supplies, eye glasses, contacts and whites. Whites include 8 pair of underwear, socks, t-shirts and bras. 2 pair of thermal underwear. (all items must be white, brand new in the unopened package from the store)
- Inmates are allowed to have 7 pictures and 3 books/magazines in their cell. These items can not be dropped off, they must be mailed.
- All mail must be delivered to the jail through the post office, UPS or Fed Ex. No dropping off of item is permitted except for those listed above.
