MEETING OF THE LAND INFORMATION COMMITTEE TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 16, 2008 LAND INFORMATION CONFERENCE ROOM

1. Chairperson Sauve called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.
2. APPROVAL OF AGENDA
MOTION (Guarisco/Nichols) to approve the agenda and addendum as presented. Motion carried, no negative vote.
3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES
MOTION (Baumgarten/Stibbe) to approve minutes of August 11, 2008 and August 26, 2008 meetings. Motion carried, no negative vote.
4. OPERATIONAL AGREEMENT WITH USDA NATIONAL RESOURCE CONSERVATION SERVICE
MOTION (Guarisco/Policello) to approve the agreement and forward to County Board for approval pending Corporation Counsel approval of the agreement language. Motion carried, no negative vote.
5. SNOWMOBILE ROUTE THROUGH HARMONY ARBORETUM FOR 2008/2009 SEASON (Main)
MOTION (Pillath/Policello) to approve the usage and grooming of that portion of the proposed snowmobile trail that enters into Harmony Arboretum by the Strutz property and continues to County E through the fields towards Coleman and not to approve that portion of the trail that borders the south side of the Memorial Forest and extends to the southeast part of the property.

(Amendment)
MOTION (Guarisco/Policello) the snowmobile clubs can groom and utilize that portion of the snowmobile trail that borders the south side of the Memorial Forest and extends to the southeast part of the property, only upon completion of the bridge and connection of the trail to Peshtigo. Motion carried, Supervisor Pillath opposed.

MOTION (Pillath/Policello) to approve the usage and grooming of that portion of the proposed snowmobile trail that enters into Harmony Arboretum by the Strutz property and continues to County E through the fields towards Coleman and to groom and utilize that portion of the snowmobile trail that borders the south side of the Memorial Forest only upon completion of the bridge and connection of the trail to Peshtigo. 6. TOWN OF PESHTIGO ZONING ORDINANCE AMENDMENTS

MOTION (Nichols/Pillath) to approve and forward to County Board for approval the Town of Peshtigo amendments to create section 13-1-144 Temporary Non-Metallic and Quarrying Operations of the Town of Peshtigo's Code of Ordinances. Motion carried, no negative vote.

7. AMENDMENTS TO TOWN OF GROVER ZONING ORDINANCE AND REZONE OF PARCEL # 014-0117.001

MOTION (Pillath/Guarisco) to forward to County Board for approval the amendment to the Town of Grover Zoning Ordinance to amend Section 10.0511 Temporary Uses and creating Section 10.0511 E. Temporary Non-Metallic and Quarrying Operations. Motion carried, no negative vote.

MOTION (Nichols/Policello) to approve the Town of Grover rezone of parcel number 014-0117.001 in NE NW S27 T30N R22E from A1-Agriculture to B2-Highway Business and forward to the County Board for approval. Motion carried, no negative vote.

8. TOWN OF NIAGARA ZONING ORDINANCE AMENDMENTS

MOTION (Guarisco/Nichols) to approve and forward to County Board for approval the Town of Niagara Zoning Ordinance amendments. Motion carried, no negative vote.

9. ADDRESSING IN UNINCORPORATED AREAS AND REVIEW THE PROPOSED ORDINANCE LANGUAGE

MOTION (Guarisco/Baumgarten) to refer the proposed amendments to Chapter 9.06, with requested changes, to Corporation Counsel for review and upon approval of the Corporation Counsel bring the proposed amendments back to committee to set a public hearing date. Motion carried, Supervisor Pillath opposed.

10. PERPETUATION AND REMONUMENTATION OF THE PLSS WITHIN MARINETTE COUNTY

Committee Chair requested that all the parties involved (Corporation Counsel, County Clerk, Public Works Administrator, County Administrator, Land Information Director and Supervisor Pillath) work on a plan that will address Supervisor Pillath's concerns in the event the County receives a notice as referenced in the Wis. Statutes 59.74 (2) (b) and present the plan to the Committee for discussion and consideration at a future meeting.

11. 2009 USER FEES FOR LAND INFORMATION DEPARTMENT

MOTION (Guarisco/Stibbe) to approve and forward to County Board the 2009 User Fees for the Land Information Department as presented. Motion carried, no negative vote.

12. 2009 LAND INFORMATION BUDGET

MOTION (Baumgarten/Nichols) to approve the 2009 Land Information Budget as presented. Motion carried, no negative vote.

13. ANIMAL & PLANT HEALTH INSPECTION SERVICE COOPERATIVE SERVICE AGREEMENT

MOTION (Guarisco/Policello) to enter into an agreement with the Animal & Plant Health

Inspection Service Cooperative Service Agreement for bear trapping in 2009. Motion carried, no negative vote.

14. FALL COUNTY CONSERVATIONIST MEETING

MOTION (Nichols/Baumgarten) to authorize the staff to attend the Fall County Conservationist Meeting in Waupaca on October 16 and 17, 2008. Motion carried, no negative vote.

15. SOIL & WATER RESOURCE MANAGEMENT BUDGET

MOTION (Guarisco/Stibbe) to approve the Soil & Water Resource Management budget increase by recognizing the additional \$50,900.69 in revenue and increasing Operation Expenditures (100-33-56300-498-072) by \$10,400.69 and Other Expense (100-33-56300-499-072) by \$40,500.00. Motion carried, no negative vote.

15. VOUCHERS

MOTION (Stibbe/Guarisco) to approve vouchers as presented (\$9,834.19). Motion carried, no negative vote.

MOTION (Guarisco/Pillath) to approve vouchers over \$5,000.00 (\$363,654.16) and forward to County Board. Motion carried, no negative vote.
