1. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Sauve at 9:00 a.m.
2. APPROVAL OF AGENDA
MOTION (Nichols/Fendryk) to approve the December 10, 2012 agenda as presented. Motion carried no negative vote.
3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES
MOTION (Holley/Whiting) to approve the minutes of November 5, 2012 as presented. Motion carried no negative vote.
4. REPORTS BY LAND INFORMATION STAFF
Anne Bartels, Education Specialist ~ reported on the Wisconsin Association of Environmental Education Conference she attended in Door County. She gets to meet with other educators and find out the newest curriculum that is available. She became certified in Project Wild, Aquatic Wild and Flying Wild.

6. ONSITE LEACHATE TREATMENT SYSTEM IN MARINETTE COUNTY AT NORTH COUNTY LANDFILL
Land Information Director, John Lefebvre discussed the idea of using a solar operated



sprinkler system that would spray leachate over the top of the cap at the North County landfill. North County Landfill was first opened in the late 1980's and closed in the early 1990's. The leachate continues to become less contaminated as the years go by which open the opportunity for onsite treatment and disposal. The concept is during spring, summer, and fall to distribute through a solar powered sprinkler system the leachate onto the vegetation on the landfill cap and whatever leachate which does not evaporate or is not used by the vegetation would then work its way back down into the landfill. The WDNR thinks the idea has potential but will need a formal submittal with more information before granting final approval.

MOTION (Baumgarten/Fendryk) to have Bart Sexton, Sand Lake Consultants, Inc. attend a future committee meeting in either January or February 2013 to discuss in greater detail the proposed leachate disposal project. Motion carried no negative vote.

7. SOIL & WATER RESOURCE MANAGEMENT BUDGET AMENDMENT

MOTION (Nichols/Clancy) to approve the acceptance of \$16,800 in additional revenue from Dunn County to provide additional cost share funds for implementation of nutrient management planning within Marinette County. Motion carried no negative vote.

11. NOVEMBER SCHEDULE OF VOUCHERS


The November Schedule of Invoices (\$288,000.96) was presented to the committee.
