1. Call to Order

Vice Chairperson Fred Carl called the meeting to order at 8:05 a.m.

2. Approve Agenda

5. Justice System Information Sharing

Bob Majewski distributed a USA Today article regarding a study that predicts the number of inmates in US prisons will likely rise 13% by 2011. Exhibit A.

Bob Majewski informed the Committee there are nine inmates participating in educational programs. Three are receiving education through the Marinette School System and six are participating in the NWTC GED program.

Bob Majewski advised the committee that the results of an inmate education survey revealed an education need for inmates who do not qualify for education through the Marinette School System or the NWTC GED program. After Committee discussion,

Bob Majewski distributed this survey information to Bob Kellogg. Bob Kellogg will research if any additional educational resources are available to accommodate the needs of these inmates and report back to the committee in June.

6. Type of Offenders Lodged In Marinette County Jail

Bob Majewski explained the chart and documents he distributed to the Committee relating to the types of offenders lodged in the jail on the date of 3/6/07. Bob stated this information is based a typical day in the jail at this time of year. Committee discussion included the type of offender categories listed on the chart, the type of charges listed on the documents, the elimination of the Children's First program and the current job market in Marinette County.
